This is a brief summary of the Annual Implementation Report (AIR) for the Cooperation Programme Interreg V-A Greece-Italy for the programming period 2014-2020 which reports on the implementation of the programme during the calendar year 2018.



THE PROGRAMME OVERVIEW



Interreg V-A Greece-Italy Programme 2014-2020 is a bilateral and cross-border Cooperation Programme, approved by European Commission on 15 Dicember 2015, and co-funded by the European Union through the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and a national co-financing of the 2 member states Greece and Italy.

The Programme aims to help public institutions and local stakeholders to develop cross-border projects and pilot actions and to create new policy, products and services, with the final goal to improve the citizens' quality of life. The programme defines a growth strategy between Puglia and Greece with the final goal to develop a dynamic economy based on smart, sustainable and inclusive systems in several fields such as blue growth, tourism and culture, agro food and cultural and creative industries
