Interreg V-A Greece-Italy Programme 2014-2020

is a bilateral and cross-border Cooperation Programme, approved by European Commission on 15 December 2015, and co-funded by the European Union through the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and a national co-financing of the 2 member states Greece and Italy.

During 2020, the Covid-19 lockdown measures has affected our lives and work plan in Greece and Italy. As Europe responds to the COVID-19 outbreak, Interreg Greece-Italy Programme has needed to adjust the plans by reviewing the situation and looking into how we best support the funded projects in this period. The Programme suggested some smart working tools to plan all the events, training sessions and activities and published a list of flexibility rules to apply for the project implementation.

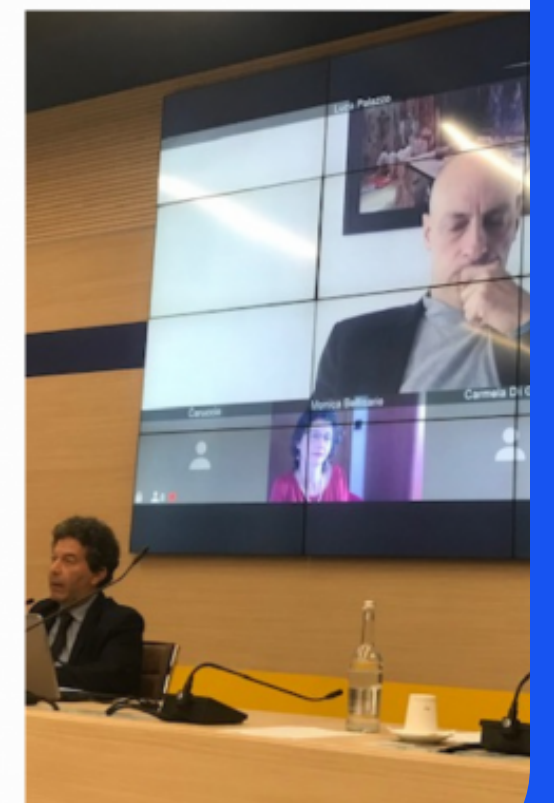
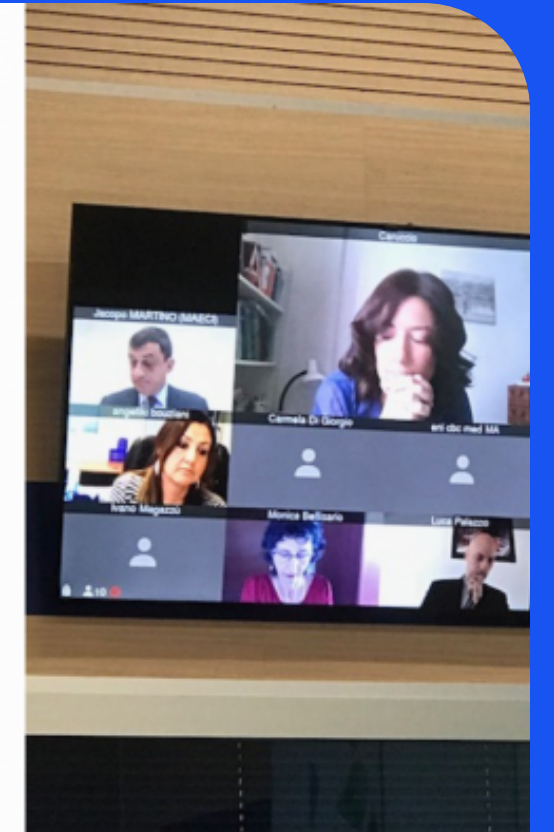

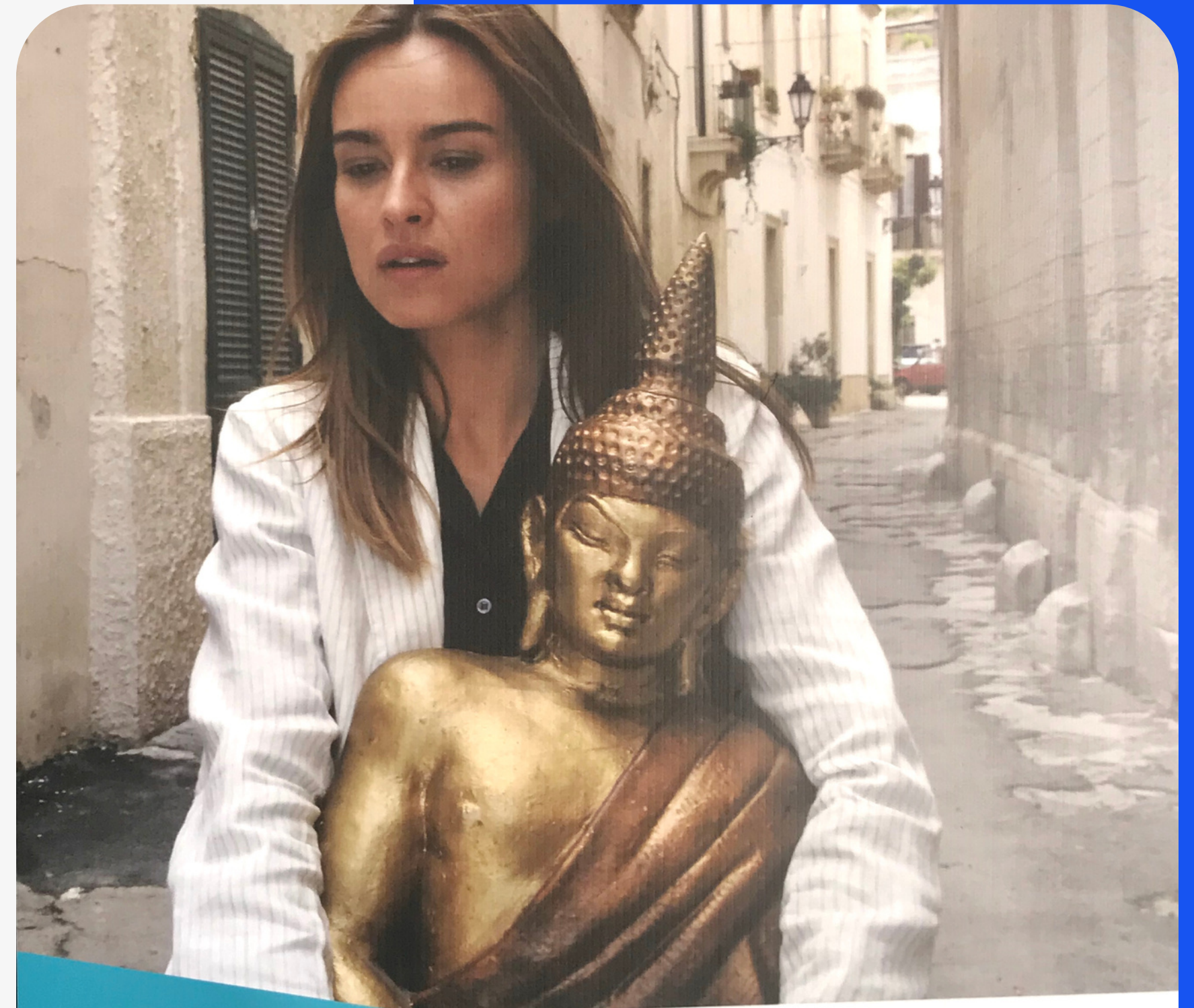
An event to know and celebrate the results of cooperation and to think about the common values as peace, security, inclusion and progress on the basis of the next programming period.

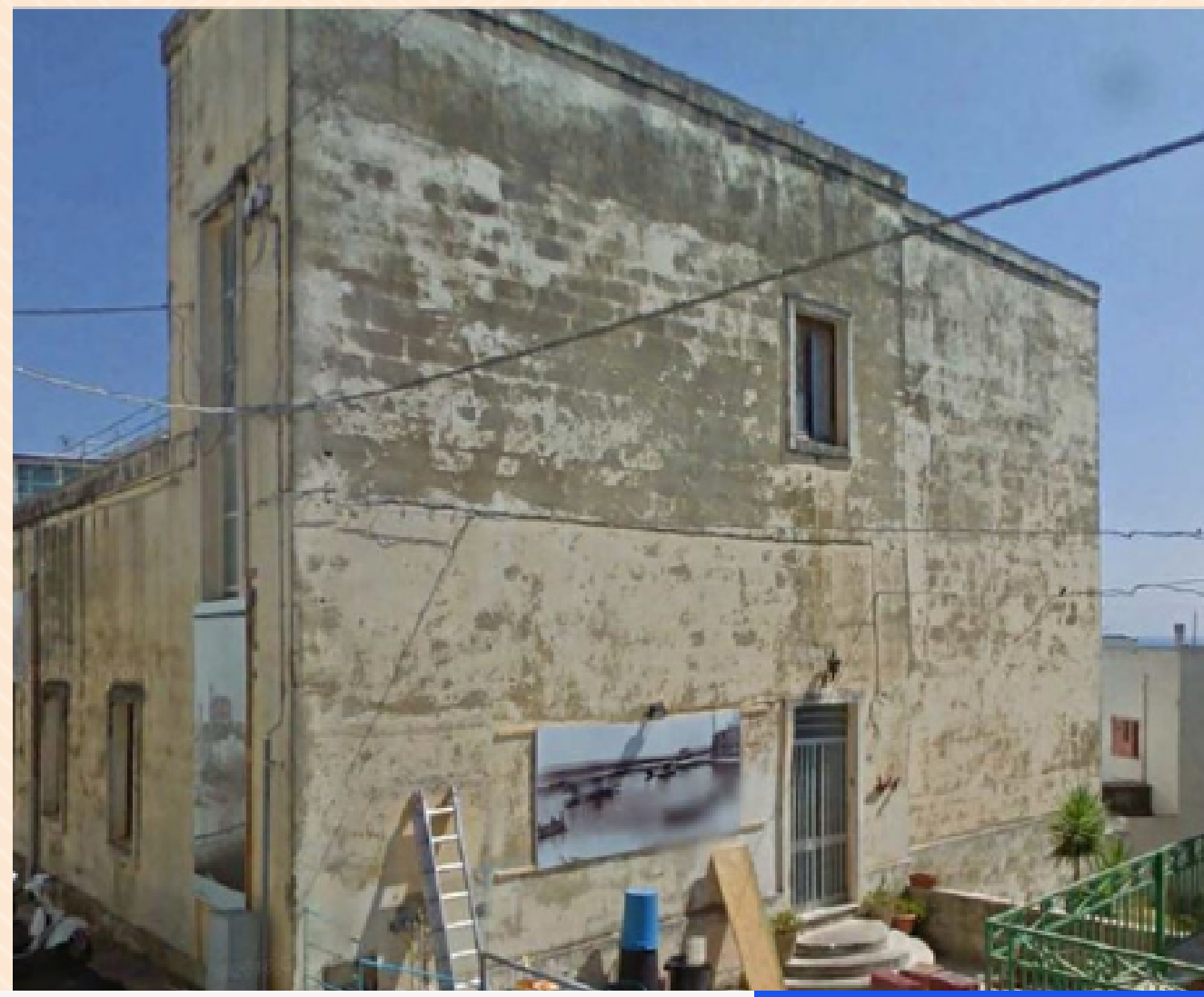

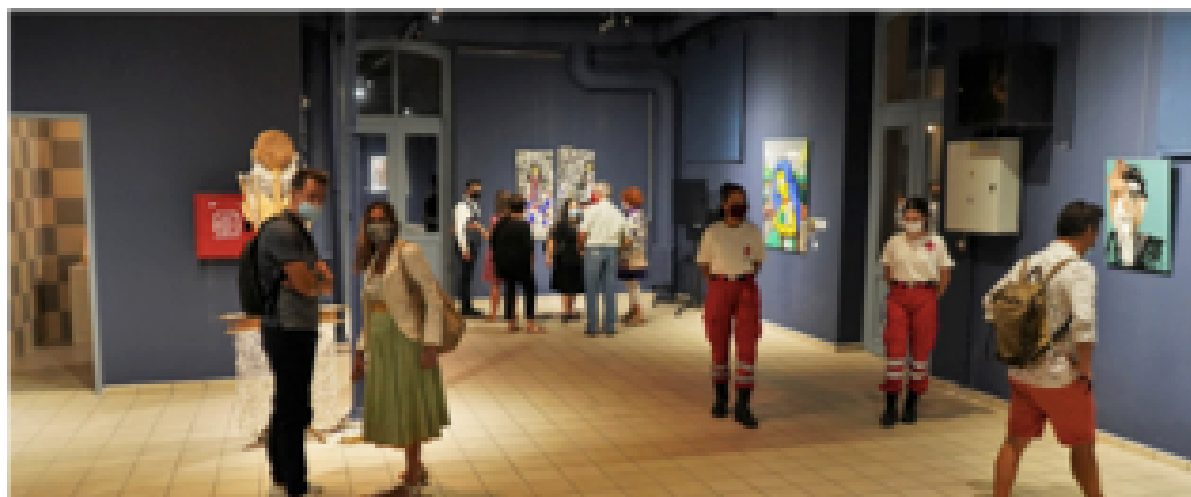

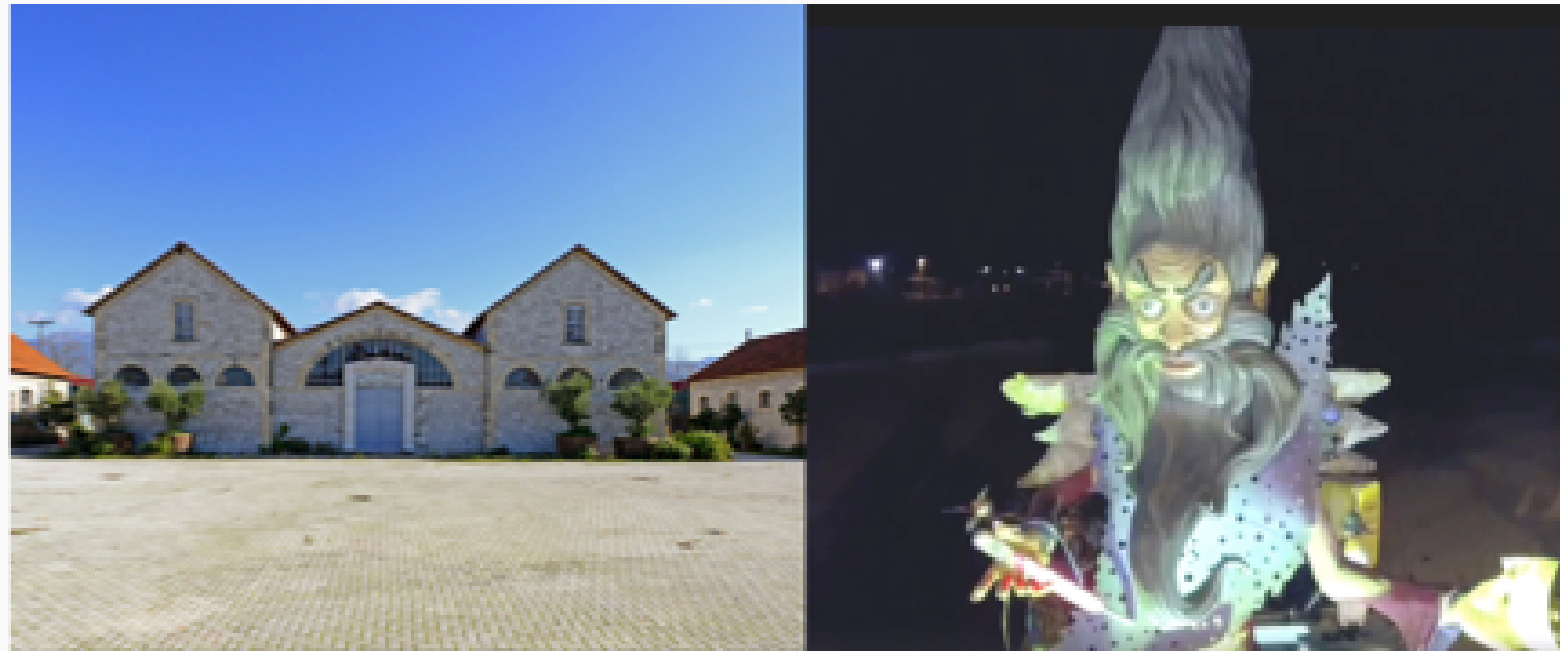
Interreg Sparc project
