Music, theatre, performances and dance will animate the itineraries, which combine walks with cultural workshops, paths with stories, testing a form of slow and innovative tourism that involves culture in all its aspects and expressions.

The European Cooperation Day is an initiative promoted by the European Union, on 21 September each year, to reflect on and highlight the results achieved by the 72 Territorial Cooperation Programmes financed throughout the territory of the Union. Under the motto "Sharing borders, growing closer", we celebrate the cooperation work between Puglia and Greece, which together face the common challenges of territorial development, promotion of culture, tourism and identity.

These two projects are in line with the commitment of the Puglia Region to promote policies with local ccompany accommodation facilities with itineraries for trekking, cycling, which are also linked to the history of the territory.

The two projects also include actions to improve reception: the towers and lighthouses along the coast are a very characteristic element of Apulia; restoring them and making them reception and information points with a common thread linked to the sea is a very important action because it makes them usable and useful and includes them in a route and itinerary to be offered to Apulians and travellers.

The Via Francigena and the historical paths of Apulia are another important must for Apulia, which has seen the recognition by the European Association of the paths of the Via Francigena as far as Santa Maria di Leuca. The fact that these two projects are in cooperation with Greece is a significant added value: the routes will be cross-border between two well-connected and friendly regions of Europe.

"CoHeN - Coastal Heritage Network" https://interreg-cohen.eu/ aims to create an itinerary of the Adriatic-Ionian Coast, connecting some important historical coastal buildings in Apulia and Greece.

In Apulia the project will restore three coastal towers, Torre di San Felice at Vieste, Torre Calderina at Molfetta and Torre Pietra at Margherita di Savoia, and three lighthouses, San Cataldo at Bari, Faro di Punta Palascia at Otranto and Faro Torre Carlo V at Ugento, to transform them into information and exhibition centres, stages in a network of places to tell the story of the sea and the coast, but also starting points for learning about the heritage of each territory.

"TheRoute_Net - Thematic Routes and Networks" https://greece-italy.eu/rlb-fundedprojects/therout_net/ aims at enhancing cultural and thematic itineraries and historical routes in Apulia and Greece. In Apulia, the project will restore eight public buildings to create the first network of hostels along the Via Francigena and the historical routes of Apulia, creating a system of reception and related services for walkers and tourists.
