Make the knowledge and results generated by projects widely accessible

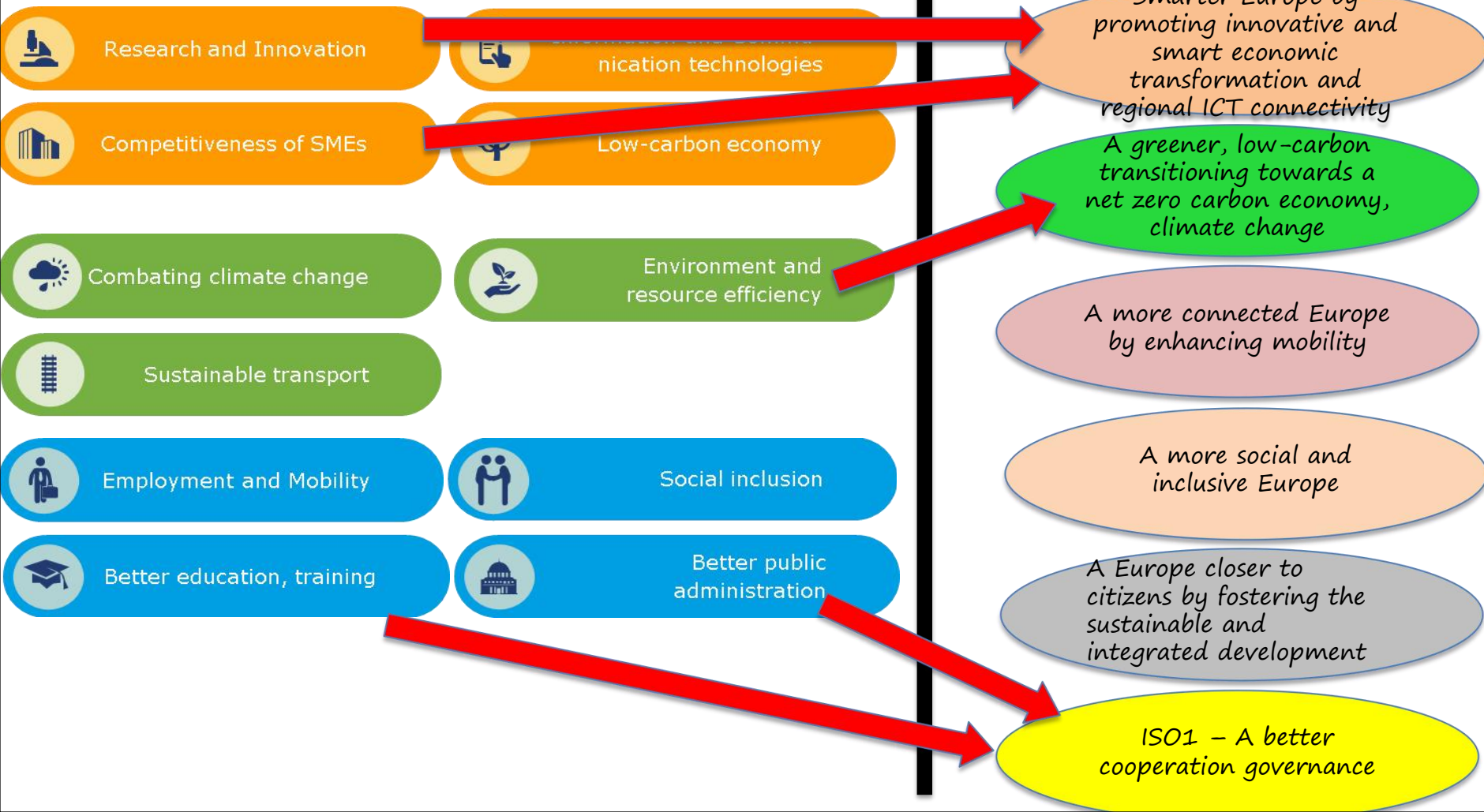
Increase the impact of project results by promoting their re-use and transfer
