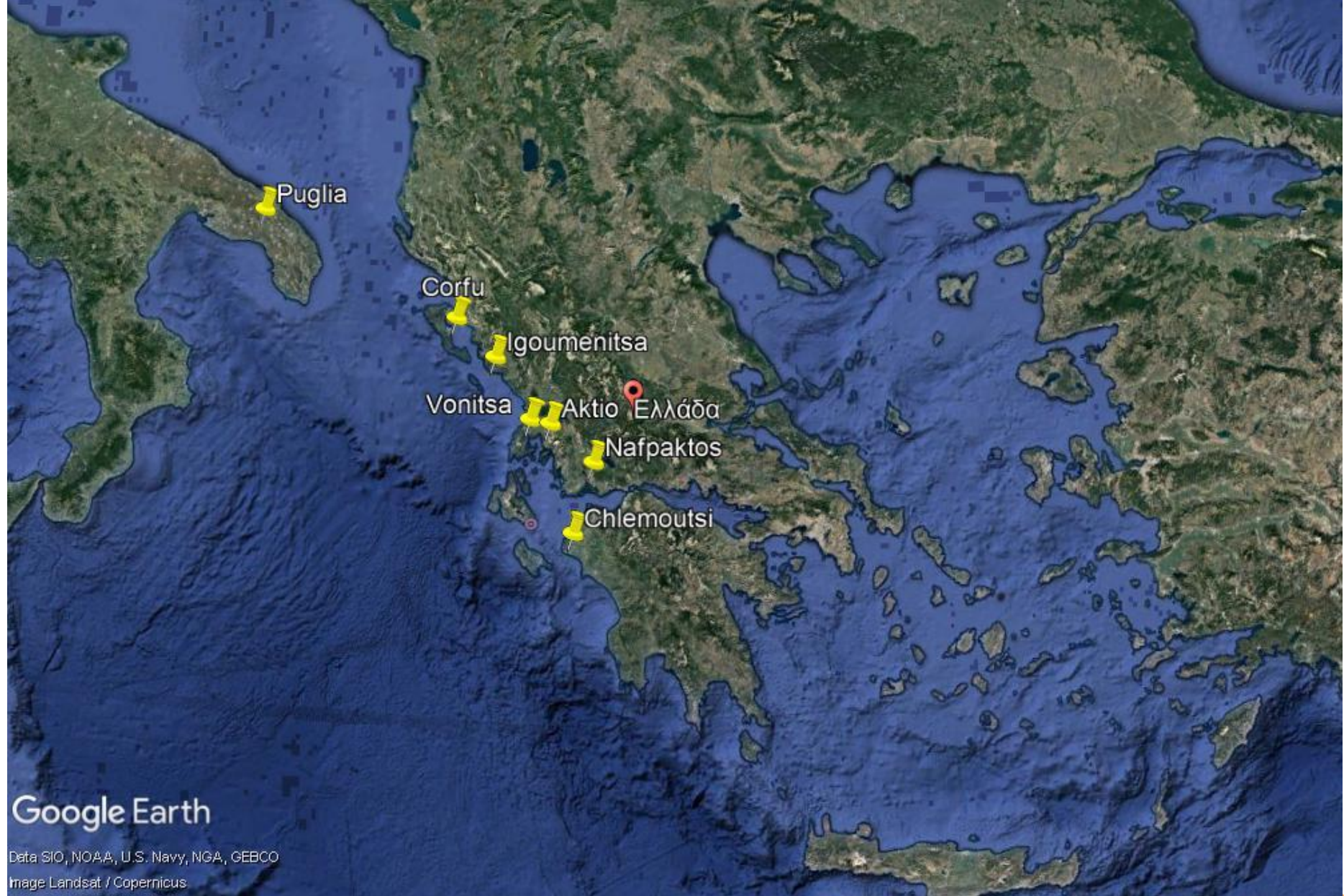

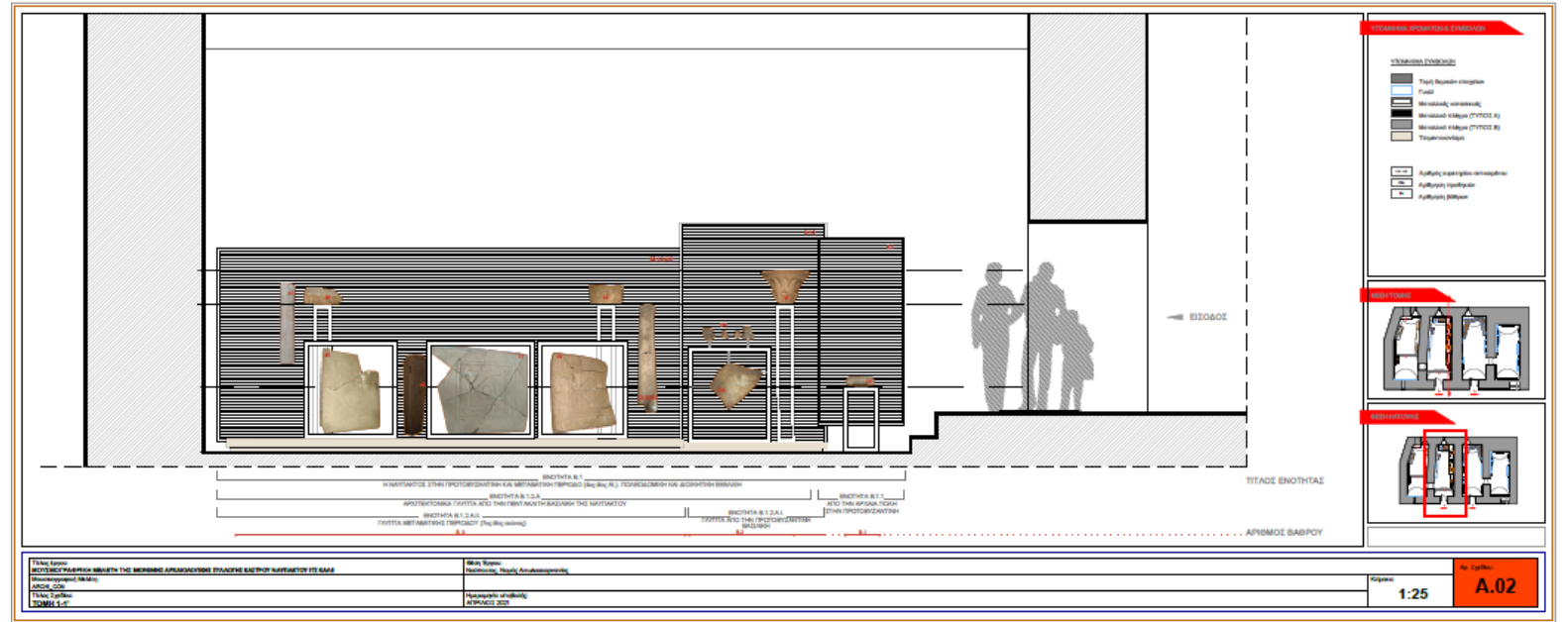

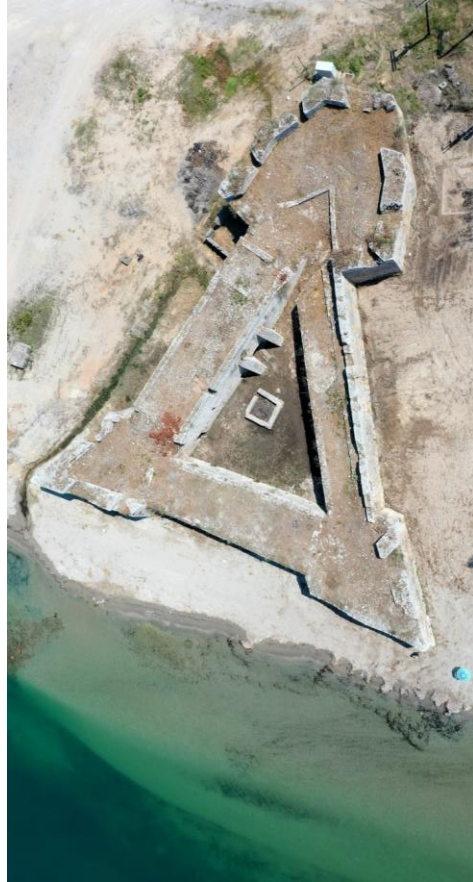

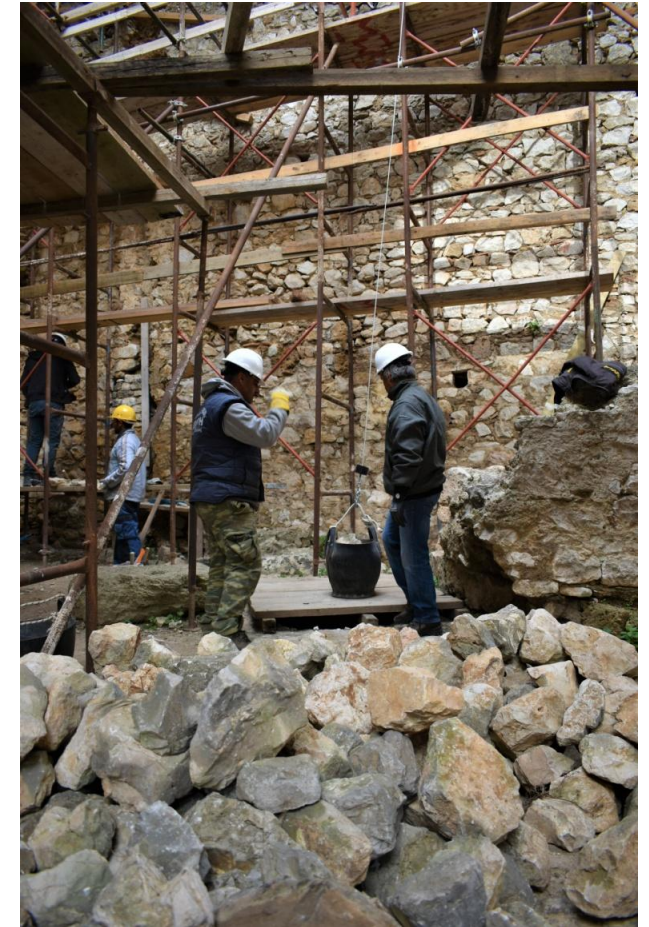

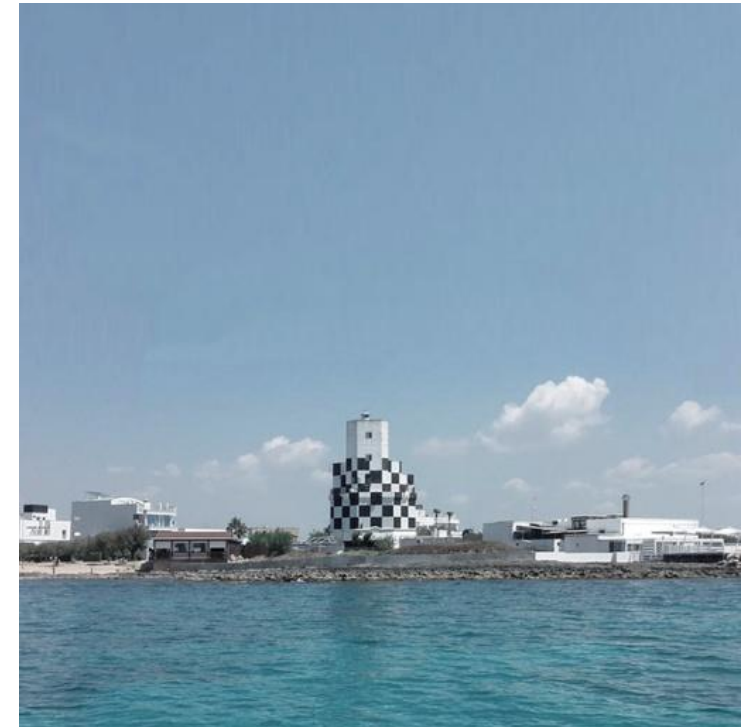

CoHeN is a strategic project funded by the Interreg Greece-Italy 2014/2020 Programme that aims to promote cultural tourism through the valorization of the Adriatic-Ionian Coastal Route by creating a network of historic built heritage landmarks across the cross-border area.

The Project

The two countries comprise an impressive number of cultural heritage sites, monuments and buildings of all periods, including sites on the UNESCO World Heritage List. These cultural heritage resources are concentrated in strategic geographical contexts, making it possible to create synergies between the various sites of the Adriatic and Ionian Seas by linking them.

The Adriatic-Ionian Coastal Route project aims to be achieved through the rehabilitation of 17 monuments and buildings, the creation of 60 km of walking routes and the development of a public network of maritime architecture, hosting tourists and visitors, permanent archaeological and historical information centers and accommodation facilities related to the Adriatic and Ionian Seas. For this reason the buildings will be adapted as public spaces or small enterprises such as the function of shops, galleries, workshops or workshops.

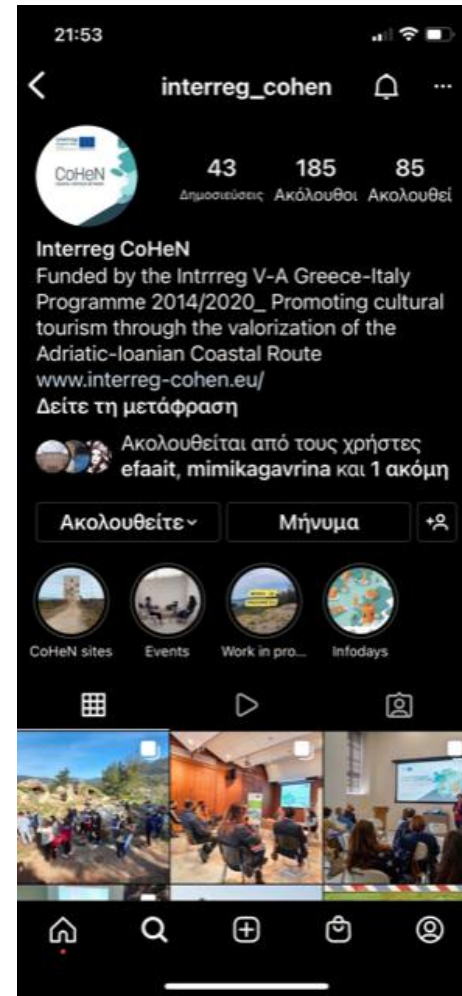

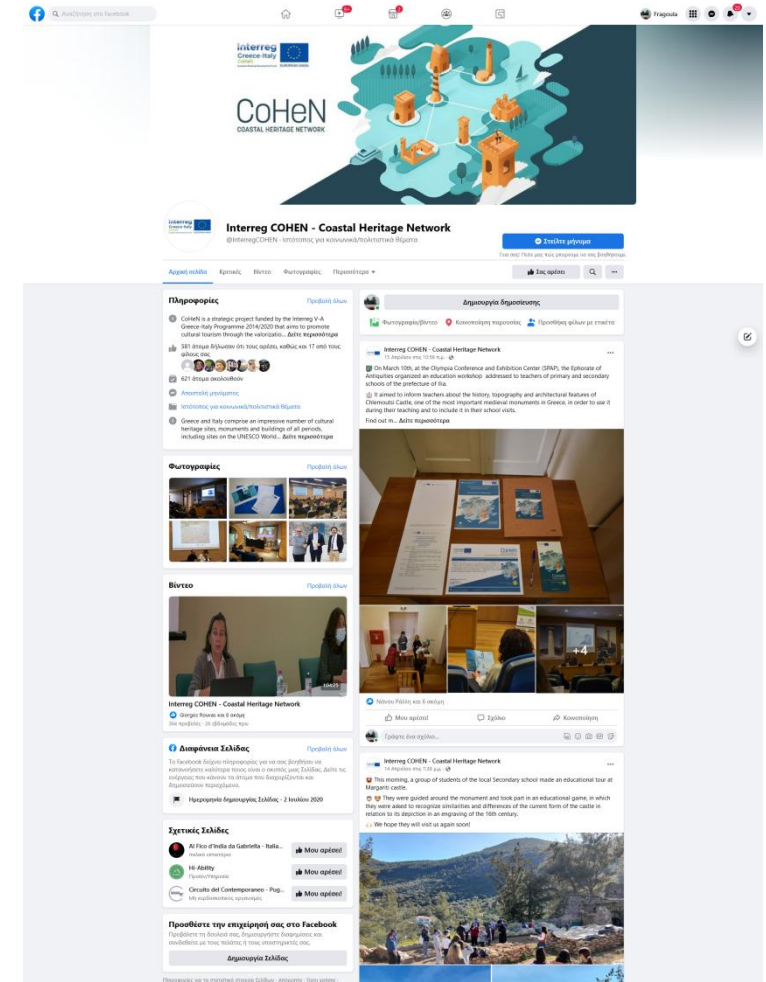

CoHeN: Expected outputs

- Increase of the tourist flow throughout the year on the Ionian and Adriatic coasts
- Protection, restoration and enhancement of cultural heritage and selected monuments in the cross-border area
- Increasing knowledge and awareness of the development of cultural heritage
- Strengthening of the participatory process at local level
- Promoting common historical elements of the cross-border region
- Producing new tools for integration into local cultural strategies
- Creating new employment opportunities in the cross-border region
- Improving the management and administrative capacity of stakeholders/partners



CoHeN: Adriatic – Ionian Coastal Route

- The Adriatic - Ionian Coastal Route is formulated through the application of 4 innovative actions that constitute the “Heritage Management Development Tool” which will improve the management & promotion of the cross-border area’s heritage:
 - 1st Action: analysis for the identification of the Adriatic – Ionian Coastal Route: maritime architectures, cultural heritage, industrial archaeology, coastal natural environments, civil and military maritime economy, immaterial cultural heritage
 - 2nd Action: Coastal Creative programme: a cultural program to support the coastal heritage valorization (theatre, narrative, visual arts, videomapping, dance, photo exhibition, etc.) and educational programs (app games and board games)
 - 3rd Action: Dissemination and enhancement of the Coastal Route: Workshops for the creation of new services managed by private enterprises and sensibilisation workshops for public and private enterprises for the development of the Coastal Route
 - 4th Action: the transnational & interregional workshops for enhancing the cooperation for the Adriatic Ionian Coastal Routes' development.

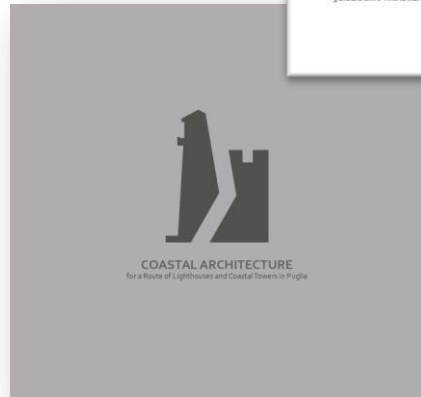
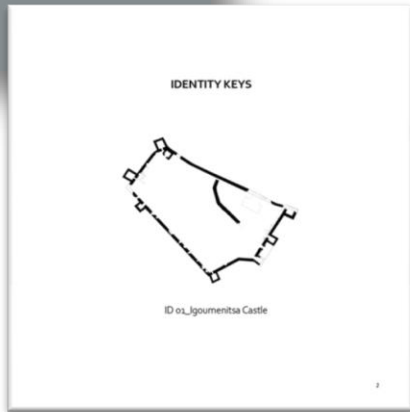

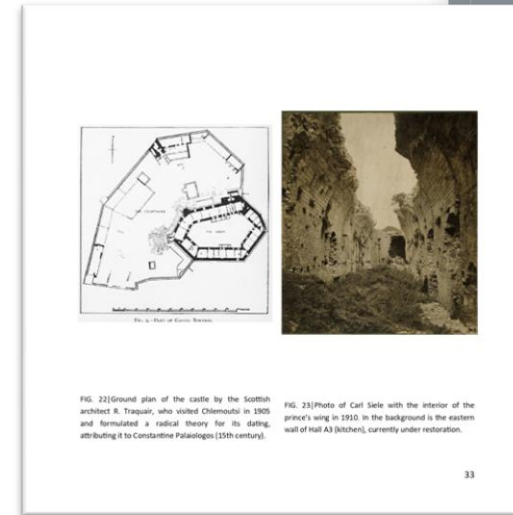
